

ANOTHER GROUP WINNER FOR DERBY WINNER SINNDAR

Sinndar, whose daughter **Pictavia** was a gallant third in Friday's Gr.1 Oaks, gained another Group winner yesterday, when **Shawanda** was the easy winner of the Gr.3 Prix de Royaumont at Chantilly.

The three-year-old daughter of Sinndar – yet another successful first crop sire – is owned and bred by His Highness The Aga Khan.

RIDGE AND SWING DAUGHTERS DOMINATE AT HAYDOCK

The Irish National Stud celebrated a Listed 1 – 2 when **Indian Ridge's Indian Maiden** beat **Celtic Swing's Slip Dance** in the Cecil Frail Stakes at Haydock Park.

Indian Maiden was held up but made headway a furlong from home. She took the lead inside the final furlong and ran on well to win by three lengths from Slip Dance.

Indian Maiden was bred by Shadwell Estates and is owned by Chris Scott and Peter Hall. She was bought for Ir£20,000 at Tattersalls (Ireland) September Yearling Sale and was subsequently sold for 21,000gns at last year's Tattersalls December Mares Sale.

ANOTHER WINNER FOR MOZART

The late **Mozart** sired another winner yesterday when **Saville Road** was the winner of the a six furlong maiden at Doncaster.

The colt, who hails from the same family as Derby winner **Motivator**, made all and was driven out in the final furlong to win by a length.

He was bred by Dachel Stud and secured for 50,000gns at Doncaster Bloodstock's St Leger Yearling Sale.

Mozart's had his first winner last week when the Ascagnano-bred **Amadeus Wolf** won a six furlong EBF maiden at Ayr.

FIRST WINNER FOR TIZNOW

Dual Gr.1 Breeders' Cup Classic winner **Tiznow** sired his first winner on Friday, when **Folklore** won a five furlong maiden at Belmont Park by four lengths.

The son of **Cee's Tizzy**, who also won the Gr.1 Santa Anita Handicap and was the 2000 Horse of the Year in North America, stands at WinStar Farm. His fee for this year was \$30,000 (LF).

A tremendous victory for **Motivator**, his owners all 230 of them, his trainer Michael Bell and his sire **Montjeu**, who also sired the second home **Walk In The Park**.

Always handily-placed behind the pacesetter **Hattan (Halling)**, he challenged the leader two furlongs out and then accelerated clear to win impressively by five lengths. His paternal half-brother **Walk In The Park** finished fast in the closing stages to take second with **Dubawi (Dubai Millennium)** three lengths back in third.

Motivator is the third foal of the one mile Goodwood Listed Conqueror Stakes winner **Out West (Gone West)**, whose previous progeny include the American winner **Warsaw Girl (Polish Precedent)**. **Out West's** three winning half-siblings include the Gr.3 Lamplighter Handicap-third **Auggies Here (Hilal)**. Their dam, **Chellingoua (Sharpen Up)**, is a placed half-sister to the Gr.1 Haskell Invitational Handicap and Gr.2 San Fernando Stakes winner and sire **Wavering Monarch**, Gr.3 Prix de Sandringham and Prix Chloee-third **Florenza (Wajima)**; dam of the Valedictory Handicap winner **All Canadian** and grandam of the Brazilian Gr.2 winner **Kahyasin** and the Stakes-placed **Quiet Foxy**, **Ruby Green (J O Tobin)**; dam of the Stakes winner and Gr.1 Metropolitan Handicap-third **Gervazy** and the Gr.1 Carter Handicap-third **Western Borders** and **Pretty In Green (Green Forest)**; dam of the Gr.2 Illinois Derby

Out West's yearling is a full-brother to Motivator, who is likely to head to Tattersalls this autumn, and she is in foal to Montjeu again.

Hazyview (Cape Cross) made the running tracked by the second **Brunel (Marju)**. Turning into the straight, Hazyview was challenged by Brunel, but the former just kept pulling out a bit more and quickened again in the final furlong to win by two and a half lengths.

The South African-bred Grand Emporium (National Assembly) ran well but struggled to get to grips with the unusual camber of the straight at Epsom.

Hazyview, whose other victories include the Listed Newmarket Stakes and the Fairway Stakes, can not be faulted for guts as he showed yesterday when winning this race. He has raced with credit against the best in the United Kingdom, France and the United States.

He is the best foal to date of his dam **Euridice (Woodman)**, who won once at three. She is a half-sister to four other winners, including the Listed Paoli Peaks Handicap-third **Arctic Bay (Gold Crest)** out of the dual winner **Arctic Kite (North Stroke)**. She is a half-sister to the Listed-placed **Run For Ever (Runnett)** out of **Exemplary (Sovereign Lord)** who was second in the Gr.2 Lowther Stakes and third in the Gr.3 Star Fillies Stakes.
